Bus or Streetcar: Senior citizens 65 years of age and older pay 40 cents to ride the bus or streetcar, and transfers are free. You must present to the bus driver or streetcar conductor an ID that proves your age in order to qualify for the lower fare. An RTA **Airport Express bus** will also take you to or from the airport for \$1.50 fare.

Airport Transportation: The Jefferson Transport **Airport E-2** route provides best service to/from Louis Armstrong New Orleans Int'l Airport into New Orleans. Airport bus stop is on second level of the Terminal, near Delta counter, outside in the median (look for sign and bench). Fare from Airport to downtown (near our hotel) is \$2.00.
